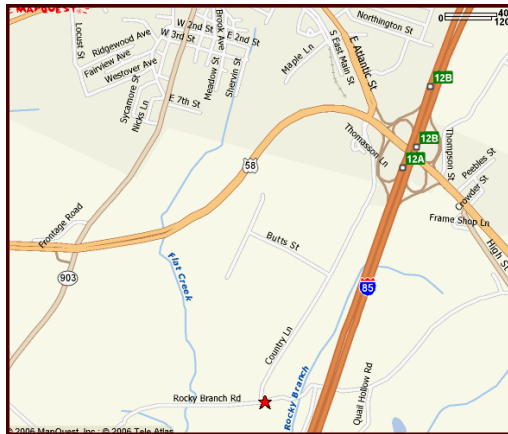

Driving Directions

Traveling from the North:

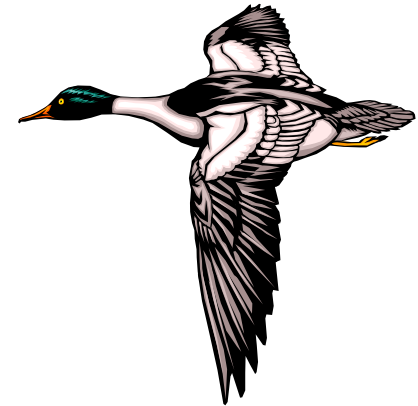
- Take I85 South
- Take Exit 12B toward VA-47/South Hill/Chase City
- Keep LEFT at the fork in the ramp
- Turn RIGHT onto US-58W / E Atlantic St.
- Go approximately .3 of a mile and turn LEFT onto Country Lane
- Follow Country Lane until it ends; turn LEFT onto Rocky Branch Rd.
- Follow to 1428 Rocky Branch Rd. South Hill, VA 23970



Traveling from the South:

- Take I85 North
- Take Exit 12B toward VA-47 towards South Hill/Chase City
- Go approximately .3 of a mile and turn LEFT onto Country Lane
- Follow Country Lane until it ends; turn LEFT onto Rocky Branch Rd.
- Follow to 1428 Rocky Branch Rd. South Hill, VA 23970
